As a member of the Nevada Advisory Committee on Traffic Safety (NVACTS), you are a leader in Nevada's traffic safety effort. Your guidance supports the efforts of the state's Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) and a number of other traffic safety efforts and reflects the importance of transportation safety to the entire state of Nevada.

The purpose and function of the NVACTS includes the following:

Review, study and make recommendations for the following:

- **Best Practices:** Evidence-based best practices for reducing or preventing deaths and injuries related to motor vehicle crashes on roadways in this State
- **Data:** Data on motor vehicle crashes resulting in death or serious bodily injury in this State, including, without limitation, factors that cause such crashes and measures known to prevent such crashes
- **Policies:** Policies intended to reduce or prevent deaths and injuries related to motor vehicle crashes on roadways in this State
- Any other matter submitted by the Chair

Prepare and submit annual report to the Governor and to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the Legislature. Summarize activities of the Advisory Committee that address, without limitation, any issue reviewed or studied, and any recommendations made by the Advisory Committee.

Typical Meeting Schedule

NVACTS meets quarterly (February, May, August, and October) on the 1st Tuesday of the month, which is subject to change due to schedules. Meetings will be held in person in Las Vegas and Carson City via video conference.

NEVADA STRATEGIC HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN


The Nevada Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) is a comprehensive, statewide transportation safety plan which provides the framework for reducing fatalities and serious injuries across all travel modes on all public roads. The SHSP identifies key safety needs and guides investment decisions toward strategies with the greatest potential to achieve Nevada’s goal of reaching zero fatalities and serious injuries. The SHSP Action Plan includes data-driven strategies and action steps for critical emphasis areas, which will drive down fatalities and serious injuries across the state.

The work required to reduce fatalities and serious injuries requires help from safety stakeholders who represent the 6 Es of safety:

- **Equity**
- **Engineering**
- **Enforcement**
- **Education**
- **Emergency Response**
- **Everyone**

The SHSP provides high-level strategies and lays the groundwork for the accompanying Implementation Action Plan, which outlines the specific action steps and output measures for each strategy.
