Agency Updates

- Amy Davey, Nevada Department of Public Safety Office of Traffic Safety, updated that working with the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) they were able to get the governor to accept the Vulnerable Road Users (VRU) Safety Assessment report.
- There are new opportunities for grant funding through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), however not all of Nevada's laws are compliant so they do not qualify for full or partial funding.

- Occupant Protection (Vice Chair: Judith Mata):
 - Virtual Baby Safety Classes have been scheduled for every month. There has been a lot of support and interest for the classes.
 - Child passenger safety classes are being offered. There are two sessions a month with two classes, it provides education and resources.
 - Upcoming trainings for Owyhee to support local tribe ensuring there are child safety technicians in their community.
- Young Drivers (Vice Chair: Nick Nordyke):
 - There are currently additional changes being asked on GDL districted driving laws to strengthen them. Due to Nevada's current law not being in compliance it was not eligible to receive full grant funding.
 - There is a partnership with Clark County School District Police Department and locals schools to help with young drivers.
- Older Driver (Vice Chair: Amanda Brandenburg):
 - No update provided.
