Agency Updates

- **State Report:** Anita Pepper, OTS
 - Media interest in traffic safety is growing.
 - Spanish news channels are being sent messaging and graphics in Spanish.
 - LVMPD have increased event based videos on their social media channels.
- **Traffic Records Coordinating Committee (TRCC):** Kevin Tice, OTS
 - Ongoing efforts to update the Crash Form to comply with the Model Minimum Uniform Crash Criteria (MMUCC) 6. Next workshop is in April.
 - Enforcement Mobile (Brazos) Working Group meeting quarterly.
 - The TRCC received updates at their 03/18 meeting from the grant recipients and related projects.
- **Labs – Toxicological** (Terri Suffecool)
 - 4 new DREs have been completed their certifications.
 - Green Lab that was provided received a great deal of positive feedback.

- **Joining Forces: Carrie Krupp, OTS**
 - Joining Forces during Dec 16, 2024-January 5, 2025, Update
 - 28 agencies, 101 DUI arrests, 454 citations, 2,620 contacts, 130 arrests, 147 SFTS performed.
 - Joining Forces during February 8–23 took place, but the stats are not complete. An update will be provided at a future meeting.

Presentation – Deborah Huff

- NV is the only state that has ARIDE in the basic academy. Over time, this has found to be problematic. Many things learned in academy get forgotten and many FTOs have never had ARIDE training themselves so they can't provide that training.
- LVMPD is now including ARIDE training for all FTOs along with a wet lab.
- Some departments haven't received SFST or ARIDE refresher in over 5 years. IACP suggests every 3 years.
