4. Safety Communications Update

The new “What’s Your Goal?” Zero Fatalities video has been released and can be viewed [here](#). Research and re-branding to refresh Nevada’s traffic safety messaging and communications program is ongoing but this video continues to emphasize that zero deaths is still Nevada’s goal. The video will be used in speaking engagements and presentations; please contact the Office of Traffic Safety to use the video.

Other on-going safety communications include messaging for the 100 deadliest days of summer with graphics out at the lake, messaging surrounding speeding and impairment for Christmas and New Year’s Eve and the Fourth of July through the partnership with California Office of Traffic Safety.

6. Establish a Dram Shop Working Group (For Possible Action – PASSED)

Nevada is one of eight states that does not impose civil liability on bars, casinos, or other alcohol vendors for harm caused by an intoxicated person.

This working group will be a noticed public meeting and will be transparent about the research and findings. 9. Nevada Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) Update Overview

The five-year Strategic Highway Safety Plan is led by NDOT but includes both local stakeholders and others from the traffic safety community.

In development of the SHSP, NDOT hosted two stakeholder workshops, one in Las Vegas and one in Carson City. Key takeaways/priorities for the SHSP include:

- Cooperative Approach with partners/agencies
- Context sensitive design
- Find a way to make safety cool – build this up, positive association in the plan
