4. Traffic Safety Data and Trends

5. 6th Street for All RTC Washoe Project Presentation

Mr. Alex Wolfson from RTC Washoe presented on the “6th Street for All” project. The project is 1.1 miles long from Virginia Street at the eastern end of the project to E. Fourth Street at the western end. The project goal is to optimize the right-of-way for all road users. RTC Washoe received a Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant of \$8.9 Million for the project. The remainder of the funding for this project will come from the Local Fuel Tax.

The project is currently in preliminary design. After the next public meeting in the Fall and environmental assessments, the project plans to reach final design by April 2026.

6. Autonomous Vehicles Working Group

A number of people have reached out to join the working group. The first meeting is anticipated to be scheduled prior to the 2025 Nevada Traffic Safety Summit (October 21-23, 2025). 6. Dram Shop Working Group

Chair Bennett shared that this working group will be paused for now, with the understanding that it could return in the future as an NVACTS Working Group. As the NVACTS Chair, Mr. Bennett looks forward to a variety of industries being involved in the conversation in the future.

8. Nevada Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) Update Overview

Lacey Tisler (NDOT) presented an overview of the 2026-2030 Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) for the state. The SHSP is currently being updated for the next five years. The plan will be organized to include the main SHSP document and a supplemental Action Plan to allow for changes and updates throughout the five-year plan.

The plan’s vision, mission, and goal were shared: highlighting a 30% reduction of fatalities and serious injuries by 2035 and an aspirational goal to reach zero fatalities and serious injuries by 2050. Ms. Tisler challenged the

audience to see if we can work together to push to set the goal to a 35% reduction by 2035, and asked agency members to consider this stretch within their respective agencies.

The SHSP document is currently being finalized in preparation for NVACTS to take action at the October 21 meeting to recommend the SHSP, which will then be submitted to the Governor for signature and FHWA for approval. Implementation of the plan will begin in January 2026. The team plans to provide the SHSP document to NVACTS members on or before October 7 for their review prior to the October 21 meeting. 10. NVACTS Annual Report

The NVACTS statutory requirements include the preparation and submittal of an annual report to LCB and the Governor by the end of the year. The annual reports typically cycle between prioritizing data analysis in the years of legislative sessions and policy analysis and recommendations in the years prior to legislative sessions.

The preliminary outline of the 2025 NVACTS Annual Report was shared along with the timeline. The draft report will be presented at the October 21 NVACTS Meeting, with an action to seek NVACTS approval on December 9. The final report is scheduled to be submitted to the Governor's Office by the end of 2025.
